Request South Bergen Municipal Joint Insurance Fund for Special Improvement District Insurance Coverage

WHEREAS, the South Bergen Municipal Joint Insurance Fund (hereinafter the Fund) is a duly chartered Municipal Joint Insurance Fund as authorized by N.J.S.A. 40A:10-36 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Edgewater is currently a member of said Fund as authorized on September 9, 2022 by resolution 2022-219 and whose term shall expire on December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Edgewater has created a Special Improvement District (SID) by adopting Borough Ordinance 2024-003 on April 15, 2024; and

WHEREAS, said purpose of the SID is for the continued preservation of the Hudson River Waterfront Walkway through consistent, efficient, and effective maintenance and repair while encouraging safety and security through the creation of a special assessment to the listed property owners as provided in Ordinance 2024-003; and

WHEREAS, a temporary Board of Trustees of the Special Improvement District was appointed by the Edgewater Mayor and Council on August 19, 2024 by resolution 2024-225 to serve for a period of eighteen (18) months for the exclusive purpose of drafting by-laws and the adoption of the 2025 operating budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Edgewater Mayor and Council hereby request that the South Bergen Municipal Joint Insurance Fund provide the necessary insurance coverage to the municipally created and endorsed Edgewater Hudson River Waterfront Walkway Special Improvement District; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Edgewater Hudson River Waterfront Walkway Special Improvement District shall abide by all municipal and state regulations in particular N.J.S.A. 40:56-83 and N.J.S.A. 40:56-84.
