**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH OF EDGEWATER TAX COLLECTOR  
TO PREPARE AND MAIL ESTIMATED TAX BILLS IN ACCORDANCE WITH P.L.  
1994 C.72**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Edgewater has adopted its budget and the Bergen County Board of Taxation is unable to certify the Borough of Edgewater’s 2025 tax bills on a timely basis; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Edgewater Tax Collector in consultation with the Chief Financial Officer has computed an estimated tax levy in accordance with N.J.S.A. 54:4-66.3, and has signed a certification showing the tax levies for the previous year, the tax rates and the range of permitted estimated tax levies; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Edgewater, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey on this the 19<sup>th</sup> day of May 2025 as follows:

1. The Edgewater Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and issue estimated tax bills for the Borough of Edgewater for the Third Installment of 2025 taxes pursuant to P.L. 1994, c72 (N.J.S.A. 54:4-66.2 and 54:4-66.3).
2. The entire estimated tax levy for 2024 is hereby set at **\$71,825,815.00**
3. In accordance with the law the Third Installment of 2025 taxes shall not be subject to interest until after August 10<sup>th</sup> or the twenty-fifth day after the date the estimated tax bills were mailed. The estimated tax bills shall contain a notice specifying the date on which interest may begin to accrue.
