COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION TITLE VI POLICY AUTHORIZATION UPDATE

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2021 authorized by Resolution 2021-172, the Borough of Edgewater endorsed its Title VI non-discrimination policy in accordance with the civil rights act of 1964, 42 U.S.S. 2000d et seq.; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2024-295 authorized on December 16, 2024 amended and updated the Borough of Edgewater Title VI non-discrimination policy in accordance with the civil rights act of 1964, 42 U.S.S. 2000d et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Edgewater applied for a grant to the Federal Transit Administration 5310 grant program through the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority for vehicle replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Edgewater has been awarded replacement Edgewater Ferry Buses as part of this program in accordance with Title VI whereby services are provided without regard to race, color, or national origin; and

WHEREAS, as a recipient of this grant, it is a requirement that the Borough to re-adopt a non-discrimination policy in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C. 2000d et seq. which prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin in any program or activity that receives Federal funds or other Federal financial assistance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Edgewater Mayor and Council hereby approve and re-adopt the attached Title VI non-discrimination policy to be applied to the FTA 5310 grant program.
