APPOINT FULL TIME VIOLATIONS CLERK

WHEREAS, the Edgewater Municipal Court is in need of a full time Violations Clerk due to a retirement; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Municipal Court Judge, Court Administrator, and Borough Administrator that a full time Violations Clerk be appointed; and

WHEREAS, the available position was duly advertised in the Bergen Record Newspaper and New Jersey League of Municipalities Magazine in print and on-line; and

WHEREAS, the Court Administrator and Borough Administrator conducted several interviews.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Jeremy S. Glass be and is hereby appointed as a full time Provisional Clerk I for the Borough of Edgewater assigned to the Edgewater Municipal Court for a three-month test period as provided by the New Jersey Civil Service Commission subject to successful background investigation, physical, and drug-screening.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said appointment shall entitle Jeremy S. Glass with a salary and benefits as provided by ordinance and current policies and procedures and overtime shall be compensated for municipal court time beyond the work day of Monday through Friday 9:00am to 5:00pm.
