WHEREAS, A mechanic position within the Department of Public Works exists due to resignation, creating a need for an appointment; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works is responsible for the maintenance and repair of all motor vehicles, heavy equipment, small equipment, police cars, fire apparatus, and ambulances; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Superintendent of Public Works as well as the Borough Administrator that a provisional full-time mechanic position be filled within the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, an advertisement was published within the Bergen Record and New Jersey League of Municipalities Magazine and several interviews were conducted based on the qualifications of the applications received, by the Borough Administrator, and Superintendent of Public Works; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Edgewater Mayor and Council that it hereby appoint the following individual to the Edgewater New Jersey Department of Public Works as provisional full-time mechanic with benefits according to the current Public Works Bargaining Unit Agreement and Salary Guide effective January 1, 2026;
