**RESOLUTION REQUESTING PERMISSION FOR THE DEDICATION BY RIDER FOR
LAW ENFORCEMENT AGAINST DRUGS (LEAD) PROGRAM REQUIRED BY N.J.S.A.
40A:4-39**

WHEREAS, permission is required of the director of the Division of Local Government Services for the approval as a dedication by rider of revenues received by a municipality when the revenue is not subject to reasonably accurate estimates in advance; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Edgewater Police Department, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey receives donation monies to be applied to funding for the Law Enforcement Against Drugs program, formally known as the DARE program; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-39 provides for the dedication of revenues anticipated from fund raising and donations as revenue and are hereby appropriated for the purpose to which said revenue is dedicated by statute or other legal requirement.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Edgewater, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Governing Body does hereby request permission of the Director of the Division of local Government Services to pay expenditures from the Law Enforcement Against Drugs trust fund monies from donations as per N.J.S.A. 40A:5-29 for the specific purposes of providing drug and alcohol-free educational events and activities sponsored by the Edgewater Police Department.
2. The Borough of Edgewater, County of Bergen is hereby directed to forward a copy of this resolution to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services through the Financial Automation Submission Tracking system.
