Dear Mr. Franz:

In response to the council meeting held last night, I wanted to clarify the quantities of material that require remediation and off-site disposal, as I think there was some misunderstanding regarding this issue at that meeting. Based on the data collected thus far, approximately 7,300 cubic yards of material exceeds the TSCA hazardous threshold of 50 parts per million (ppm). This material requires off-site disposal. Furthermore, approximately 22,100 cubic yards exceeds the NJDEP residential cleanup criteria of 0.2 ppm, which is the stated cleanup goal of the council. This material also requires off-site disposal as part of the remediation process. Therefore, a total of approximately 29,400 cubic yards of material requires off-site disposal. This quantity does not take into account the soil stockpile, some of which will likely also require off-site disposal.
