Dear Mr. Franz:

It is our understanding that the Borough has received inquiries from the public regarding the potential for dust migration due to the ongoing remediation activities being implemented at the above-referenced site (the "Site"). To ensure the safety of both on-site personnel and the general public, First Environment, Inc. (First Environment) continues to follow the procedures outlined in the Perimeter Air Monitoring Plan (PAMP) dated October 2014. Specifically, since project commencement, First Environment has continually operated three Dusttrak™ II Aerosol Monitors (Model 8530) to effectively monitor potential fugitive particulates that may be generated during excavation activities. In the event that the established action levels are exceeded, each monitor is equipped with an alarm. To date, a review of the monitoring data confirms that all particulate concentrations remain below the established action levels and no alarms have been triggered. Furthermore, as an added level of protection, Enterprise Network Resolutions Contracting (ENRC), under the direct supervision of First Environment, continues to deploy dust suppression measures (i.e., misting the excavation areas with water) at the Site.

Furthermore, as per the bid specification, ENRC is responsible for their own health and safety as well as that of its subcontractors. All personnel performing work on site are required to have completed, and be current with, their OSHA 40-hour Hazardous Waste Operations and 8-hour refresher training. Based on the nature of the materials, Level D PPE (e.g., steel-toe boots, reflective vest or equivalent, work gloves, hard hat, and safety glasses) are acceptable for the tasks currently being completed at the Site.
