BID NOTICE
VETERANS FIELD SITE REMEDIATION

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received, opened & read aloud by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Edgewater, Bergen County, New Jersey, for the **VETERANS FIELD SITE REMEDIATION** at Edgewater Borough Hall, 55 River Road, Edgewater, New Jersey, 07020, on **Wednesday, August 27, 2014 at 11:00 AM**, Local Prevailing Time.

Drawings, specifications and forms of bids, contract and bond for proposed work, will be on file at Edgewater Borough Hall, 55 River Road, Edgewater, New Jersey, starting on Wednesday, August 6, 2014, and may be examined at no expense by prospective bidders during normal business hours. Bidders, upon request, will be furnished with a compact disc (CD) containing plans and specifications upon proper notice and a non-refundable payment cost of **\$15.60** to cover the cost of reproduction. (Checks made payable to: **Borough of Edgewater**) Bids must be made on Standard Proposal forms in the manner designated herein and required by the Specifications, must be enclosed in sealed envelopes, bearing the name and address of bidder and name of the project on the outside addressed to Mayor and Council, Borough of Edgewater, Bergen County, New Jersey. The bid must be accompanied by a non-collusion affidavit and a certified check or bid bond for not less than ten (10%) percent of the amount bid, provided said check or bond need not be more than \$20,000.00 nor shall it be less than \$500.00. The bid must also contain a consent of surety from a surety company authorized to transact business in the State of New Jersey in a sum equal to one hundred (100%) percent of the amount bid with a full power of attorney for same, attesting that if the contract is awarded to the bidder, the surety will issue all required bonds as set forth in the bid specifications.

The bid must be delivered to Borough Hall, 55 River Road, Edgewater, New Jersey, 07020, prior to the time set for the opening of bids. If the bid is not hand-delivered, bidder assumes all risk associated with non-delivery by the postal service, courier service, or other delivery service. Faxed or emailed bids will not be accepted.

The Standard proposal form and the non-collusion affidavit are attached to the specifications, copies of which will be furnished on application to the Engineer. Major construction items will consist of the following:

BASE BID: Removal and disposal of an estimated 14,080 Tons USEPA Toxic Substance Control Act ("TSCA") Levels of Hazardous Soil Type Material

ALTERNATE BID: Removal and disposal of an estimated 46,000 Tons of Non-TSCA Soil Type Material

The removal or all material will be conducted at the direction of and under the supervision of the Borough's LSRP. The quantities provided are estimates only, and no minimum quantity is guaranteed. The Borough will only pay for actual quantities of material removed at the direction of the Borough's LSRP.

A pre-bid site visit meeting will be held on **Thursday, August 14, 2014, at 10:00 a.m.** prevailing time where bidders will have the opportunity to visit the site to assess the extent of the work. This is not a mandatory pre-bid meeting; however, it is highly recommended that all potential bidders attend.

In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.2, all contracts entered into with the Borough of Edgewater on or after September 1, 2004, the contractor must be registered with the New Jersey Department of the Treasury, Division of Revenue and provide a business certificate with the bid in accordance with P.L. 2004, c. 57 (N.J.S.A. 52:32-44). The contractor shall provide written notice to its subcontractors and supplier of the responsibility to submit proof of business registration to the contractor. The requirement of proof of business registration extends down through all levels (tiers) of the project. Before final payment on the contract is made by the contracting agency, the contractor shall submit an accurate list and proof of business registration of each subcontractor or supplier used in the fulfillment of the contract, or shall attest that no subcontractors were used.

The contractor will comply with all rules and regulations and orders promulgated by the State Treasurer pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et. seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27 and with all provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et. seq. and all rules and regulations promulgated there under, the provisions of which are incorporated herein by reference.

Bidders shall also comply with the provisions of the following laws of New Jersey: P.L. 1963 c. 150 (Prevailing Wage Act); P.L. 1977 c.33 (Corporation and/or Partnership Owner Information); and any subsequent amendments thereto. **This contract requires payment of prevailing wage.**

The Mayor and Council reserve the right to award or reject any or all bids, waive any minor defects, and in the case of a tie, award on the basis of the bid that in its judgment will be for the best interests of the Borough of Edgewater, and consider bids for sixty (60) days after their receipt.
