

# EPA PUBLIC NOTICE

## U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Reviews Cleanup at the Quanta Resources Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting its first five-year review of the **Quanta Resources Superfund Site**, located in Edgewater, Bergen County, New Jersey. This review will evaluate whether the remedy that was selected by EPA in a 2011 Record of Decision for Operable Unit 1 remains protective of human health and the environment. The remedy included: 2wolidification/stabilization of soil contaminated with arsenic and coal tar, primarily by in-situ solidification/stabilization (ISS); passive collection of coal tar/nonaqueous phase liquids; capping of contaminated soils remaining on site at concentrations greater than the remediation goals; installation of a subaqueous reactive barrier in Hudson River sediments to treat groundwater; and institutional controls such as deed notices and a Classification Exception Area to restrict the installation of wells and the use of groundwater.

A summary of the five-year review activities and an evaluation of the long-term protectiveness of the remedy will be included in the upcoming five-year review report. **The report is anticipated to be completed by January 2022.**

### What is an EPA Five-Year Review?

EPA inspects Superfund sites every five years to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of human health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, include:

- Inspection of the site and cleanup technologies;
- Review of monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records; and,
- Determination if any new regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized.
